Photoluminescent Safety Association 2009 Annual Conference Scheduled for March 8-10 in San Diego

Arlington, VA, July 28, 2008—The Photoluminescent Safety Association will hold its third annual conference and annual business meeting March 8-10 in San Diego, CA. The event will be held at the Marriott Courtyard. The room rate will be \$189 a night. Registration will begin in December.

I am pleased to report that based, in part, on my public testimony, as well as several other building & fire officials, and various presentations at the PSA exhibit this week, the following code change public comment for the 2009 IBC was approved today by the ICC voting membership by a two-thirds vote.

1027.22 Exit path markings. Existing buildings of Group A, B, E, I, M and R-1 having occupied floors located more than 75 feet (22,860 mm) above the lowest level of fire department vehicle access shall be provided with exit path markings in accordance with Section 1027 (Supp).

Exception: Open, unenclosed stairwells in historic buildings designated as historic under a state or local historic preservation program.

Stay tuned as more code change public comments are still pending.

PSA is dedicated to generating broad-based acceptance of safety-grade photoluminescent products. Photoluminescent products improve safety through such products as exit signs, low-level egress pathway marking systems, and general safety signage.
